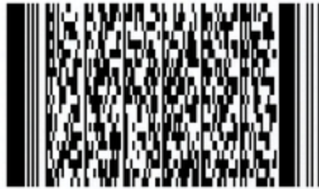

Half-day stay Programs

Our half-day stays in Osijek, Darda, Našice, Podgorač, Slavonski Brod, Požega, Vinkovci, and Virovitica host about **120 children** with behavioral issues every day.

For the children, we provide daily: Three meals, Psychosocial support, Learning assistance and counseling, Birthday celebrations.

The magic of the half-day stay programs: **No day here is the same!**

What experts work here?

Psychologists, social workers, social pedagogues, pedagogues, etc.



Safer Internet Center

To prevent online sexual violence against children and protect them from internet exploitation, we established the national Safer Internet Center (CSI) 10 years ago.

We manage an anonymous **helpline at 0800 606 606** for victims of electronic violence, where our specially trained psychologists, social workers, and social pedagogues respond to queries.

We also operate a **hotline** form for anonymous reporting of illegal internet content, reviewed by a criminologist.



The Safer Internet Center:

- ♥ Educates school staff,
- ♥ Counsels victims and their families,
- ♥ Promotes responsible technology use.

Where's My Teddy?

Every year, on May 25th, International Missing Children's Day is acknowledged. On this occasion, in Osijek, we organized a teddy bear hunt in a straw maze for children and parents as part of the event called „Where's My Teddy?“.

The goal of activities like these is to raise **awareness about missing children**, children at risk of disappearance, exploitation, and abuse, as well as to promote the Missing Children Hotline **116 000**.

Find Me Race

Every year in Osijek, we organize a race dedicated to cases of children going missing in Croatia. The race bears the symbolic name **Find Me** because participants collect kilometers with their steps, corresponding to the number of cases of children going missing. Over the past **two editions**, more than 800 runners have participated.

The youngest participant was **8 months old**, and the oldest was **86 years old**.

The race is supported by the City of Osijek, various sponsors, and the organization Missing Children Europe.
